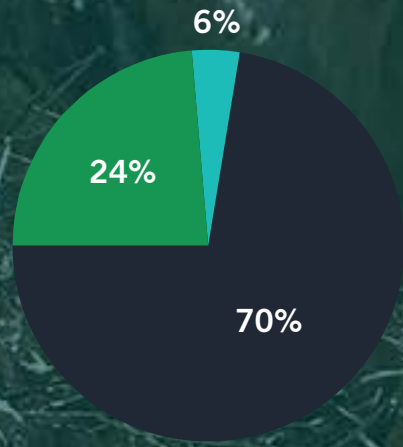


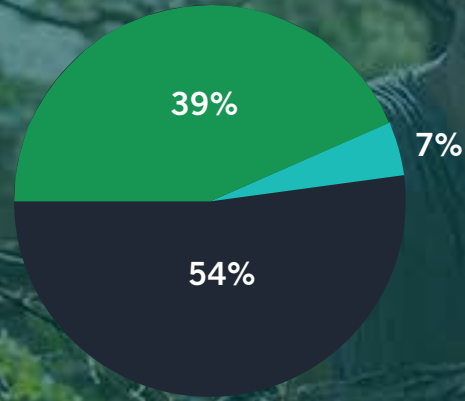

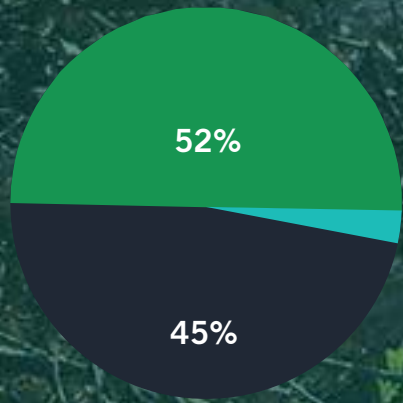
U.S. DISASTER RESPONSE

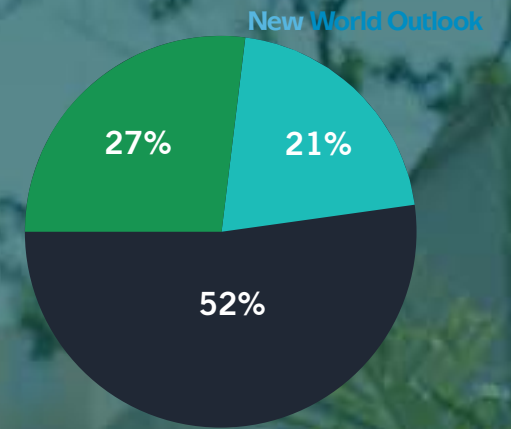

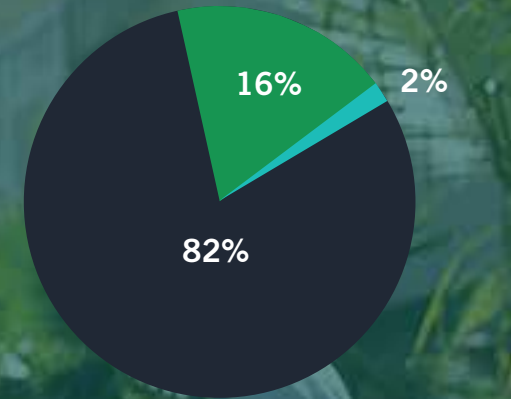

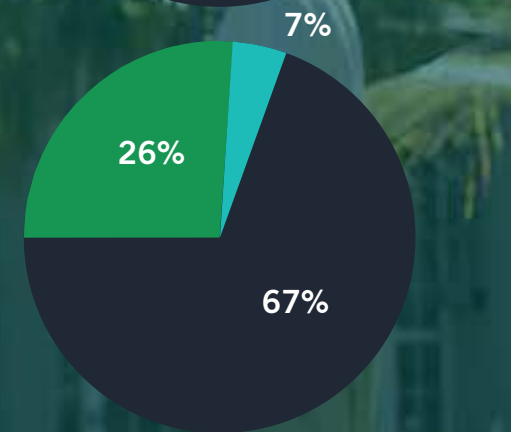

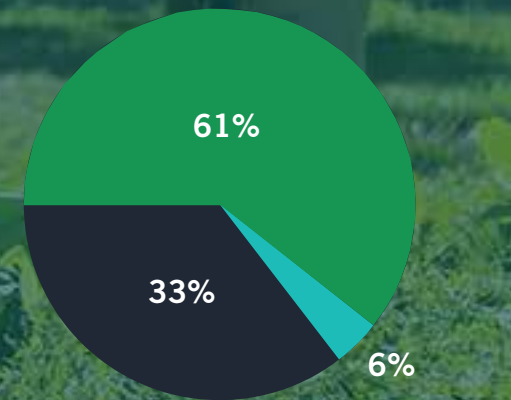
EVANGELISM AND CHURCH BUILDING
