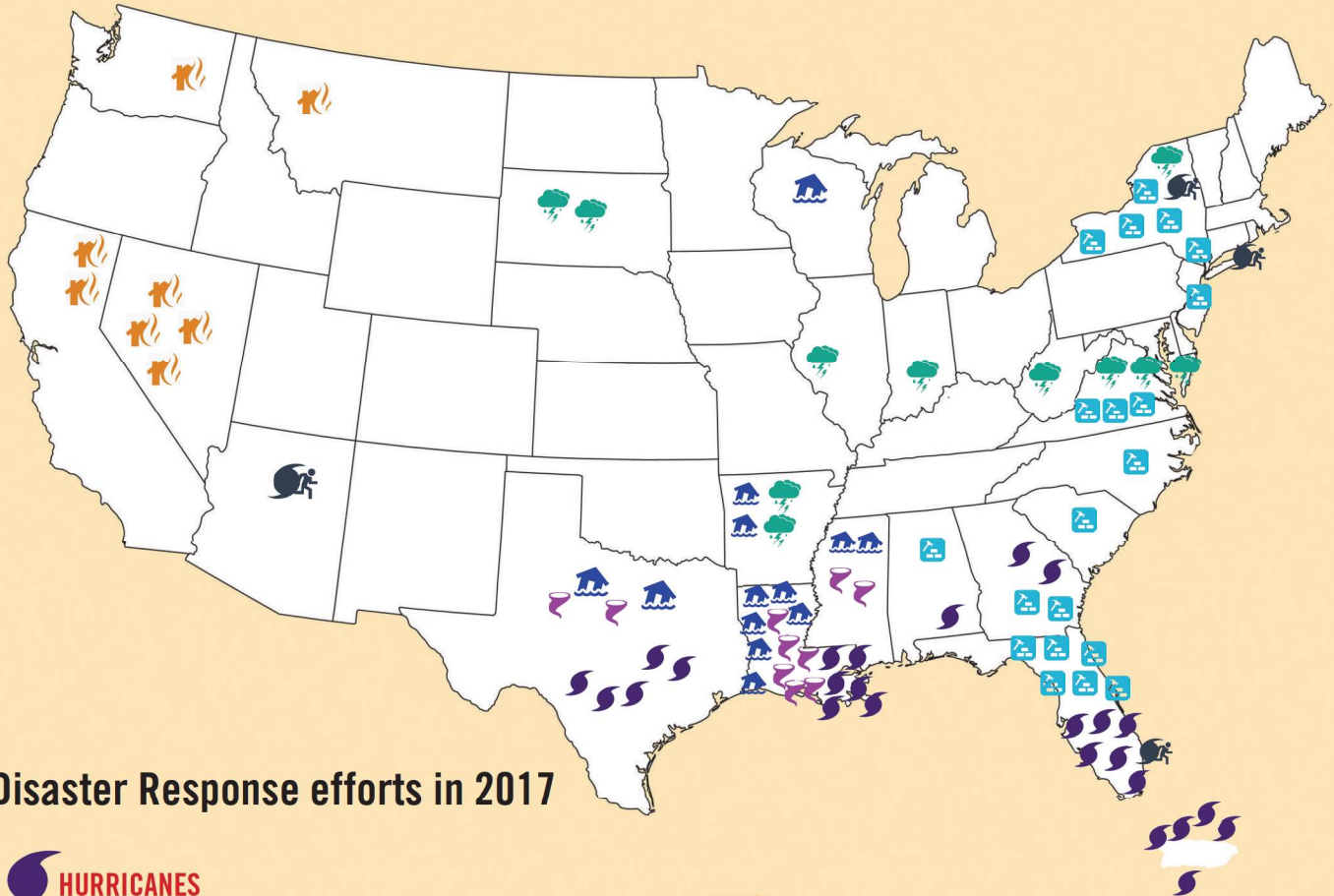


In 2017, UMCOR responded to 44 different U.S. disasters

and implemented disaster response programs with 27 U.S. annual conferences.



Disaster Response efforts in 2017

HURRICANES

Harvey—Texas, Louisiana, and Rio Texas conferences: 5 grants totaling over \$3 million. Proposals have been received for an additional \$11 million for the next 2.5 years.

Irma—Florida, South Georgia, South Carolina conferences: 3 grants totaling \$1,060,300. An additional \$9 million has been proposed.

Maria—Puerto Rico and Atlantic islands: Over \$5 million awarded with an additional \$15 million proposed for programs in 2018. Recovery will extend for years, as will UMCOR's grant funding and other support. Evacuation related to Hurricane Maria in New York and Florida, \$400,000 in grants with pending proposals to extend services.

TORNADOES

Central Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi conferences

WILDFIRES

California-Pacific, California-Nevada, Pacific Northwest, and Yellowstone conferences: \$250,000. Proposals are pending for additional support. Additional responses in 2017:

FLOODING

Arkansas, Central Texas, Michigan, and Mississippi conferences.

UN-NAMED STORMS

Arkansas, Indiana, Upper New York, Virginia, West Virginia, South Dakota annual conferences.

RECONSTRUCTION

Florida, New York, North Alabama, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina conferences: ongoing reconstruction to mitigate damage from major storms in previous years.

In 2017, U.S. Disaster Response implemented 61 grants totaling \$21,570,611.
